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## UNDERSTANDING THE TYPES OF APPLICATIONS

### WHAT AND WHO SHOULD TAKE THIS COURSE

This course was created to aid those just starting out in the landscape lighting trade. It also serves to educate those newer to this form of lighting design practice. For example, landscape architects, interior designers, and other disciplines can benefit greatly from this program.

Because there is much to consider in lighting design, ELLI has broken up this course program into two parts—**Lighting Applications I** and **Lighting Applications II**. These are explained below, and we encourage participants to take both courses to gain the full value of this learning experience.

#### **Lighting Applications I:**

We will discuss the various types of applications related to **Up lighting** (front, side, and back), **Down lighting** (adjustable, fixed, and hanging), **Path lighting** (stake-mounted & post-mounted), **Wash lighting**, **Underwater lighting**, and **Specialty lighting** (recessed, niche, string/festoon, globes, and art forms). This is a broad overview of fixture types based on conditions.

#### **Lighting Applications II:**

We will begin to look at applications and creating balance, depth, and contrast. Additionally, we will address lighting levels as they are an important consideration to scene development. This course takes our initial learning and expands upon it so the designer can begin to develop their techniques.

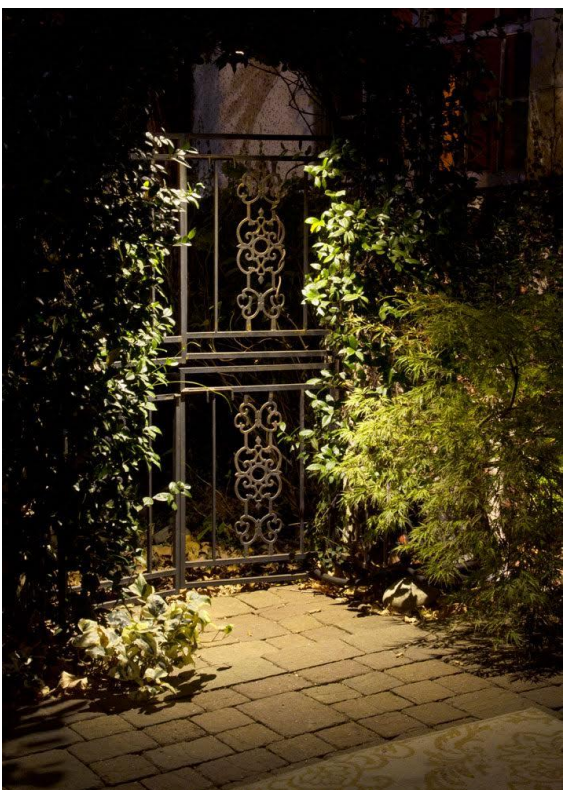
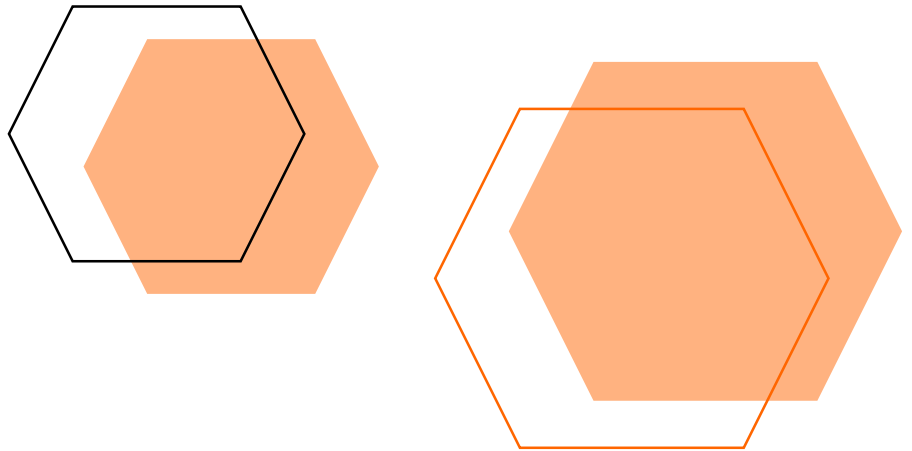
## SEASONED PROFESSIONALS PERFORMING THIS WORK

# WHEN ARE THESE COURSES OFFERED?

## COURSE SESSIONS

As mentioned above, we will break this full course into 2-parts based on understanding the initial content. Part 1 will be offered over a 5-week period and part 2 will be provided in a 4-week period. All in all, there are 9-total weeks to this program.

Each of the ELLI training sessions is provided by an online Zoom meeting, where presentation photos can be studied as a group. These class sessions will run towards the end of the workday and/or early evenings. Sessions will last from 1 to 2-hours each.

Each course program offering will have a minimum number of participants, as well as a maximum of 8-total students for a small group environment. The advantage of this is that each participant has direct exposure and learning from our instructor(s). We've found this to be the best learning environment.

3. This course is offered in a small group format, which allows for strong learning. Our instructor(s) will be able to engage in questions, as well as to identify strengths and weaknesses in each participant. This will aid in the success of each participant.
